

NATURE SCHOOL POLICIES:

- Tuition is due ON OR BEFORE the 1st of each month. I will send a reminder five days prior and another reminder the day of. If you are going to be late with a payment, please communicate with me about it. I'm very nice! If you pay after the 10th, I ask you to include a \$10 late fee.
- Although there is no contract and you are welcome to leave whenever you're ready, I cannot offer refunds for partial months if you choose to leave mid-month. All sales are final.
- Please provide a two week notice when you plan to take your child out of class so I can reach out to children on the waitlist.
- Class ends right at 12pm. Please be on time for pick-up! For the safety of your child, I ask you to inform us if someone is picking him/her up other than a parent.
- Your child MUST be potty-trained in order to attend nature school. We cannot be responsible for changing diapers.
- We will not tolerate any kind of violence or bullying at nature school. This must remain a safe place for everyone! I don't anticipate it will be a problem, but if it becomes a problem with your child, he/she will no longer be able to attend.
- Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for nature play. We will be in dirt and mud and using paint and other craft supplies...your child will get dirty! Send them in clothing that you don't mind getting roughed up.
- Additionally, please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather. In the summer I recommend a hat along with regular summer clothing. Good clothing is imperative for their safety and enjoyment! *If your child is not dressed appropriately for the weather, I will call you to either bring the right clothing or pick them up.*
- No toys or electronics from home are allowed at nature school. With our limited time together, we want this to be a full nature immersion. We have allowed toys in the past during our sharing circle, but they tend to be a source of distraction and also contention at times. All your student needs to bring is the right clothing and a full water bottle with their name on it (or something else to distinguish it.)
